# On the day...

Arrive early so you have plenty of time to sign in, mingle with other walkers, and meet our sponsors. Sign-in starts at 10:30 AM. Grab a Protector of Play flag, some bubbles and a kids kit (balloon and scavenger hunt list) for the little ones walking with you! Don't forget to pick up your superhero "Protector of Play cape!

Please make sure that a waiver is signed and submitted for each walker (including a waiver for young children). Parts of this trail are near the river, so please keep children with you at all times to ensure their safety.

Strollers and wheelchairs are welcome on this course. However, the terrain is varied (hills, paved, and unpaved trails are on this route).

This is a shared trail, so please be mindful and respectful to other people using the route. Parts of this route are also an off-leash area for dogs. Please be respectful to animals and people using the trail.

Please bring your own water bottles. Water refill station will be available at the main site.

Washrooms are available on site.








### **WALK ROUTE**
